Pirin Golf & Country Club has two golf courses exclusively for the use of our residents and guests. The pride of the club is an outstanding 18-hole, Par 72 championship course designed by the winning 2006 Ryder Cup Captain, Ian Woosnam. The second course is named after the surrounding area, i.e. Pirin Pine Course and at the moment features 5 fully constructed holes. At the moment you can play a combination of 13 holes Ian Woosnam course and 5 holes of the Pirin Pine. The 18-holes of the Ian Woosnam course will be opened for play in the summer of 2009.

Since Pirin Golf & Country Club is a Residents only complex, the golf courses are for exclusive use of members and guests of the resort; therefore reservation of tee time is only possible together with an overnight stay in the resort or one of the hotels of Bulgaria Holidays. Only people who are guests of the resort or the hotels Katarino Spa, Perun and Bulgaria are allowed to play on the golf course (this only concerns the golf course, not the practice facilities). Booking a tee time is only possible after checking in one of the hotels.

\* Those who wish to play on the course should have an official handicap by the Bulgarian or any other golf association.

## **Tee time reservation:**

The clients reserve a tee time on the hotel reception or with the Bulgaria Holidays representative while booking a hotel room.



The apartment owners, their guests, and everyone willing to play, no matter if they have official handicap will have access to the practice facilities. Everyone willing to practice can use the Driving Range and the practice facilities.

## **Ian Woosnam golf course – holes description**

### **Hole 1**

The first is a gentle par 4 without too many complications. The best line from the tee is to aim between the two large pine trees. The stream that can be seen running between the 1st and the 9th holes crosses the fairway and will come into play on the second

shot, however a good drive should eliminate most of the danger, but be careful not to pull your second shot to the left, otherwise you could still end up in the water.

## **Hole 2**

A nice downhill par 4. The bunkers on the right may be a safer option than flirting with the stream on the left.

## **Hole 3**

The first Par 3. The elevated tees may make this well guarded hole play shorter than you expect, especially if down wind.

## **Hole 4**

A nice gentle par 5. Although there aren't too many bunkers the narrow fairway means you still have to keep it straight.

## **Hole 5**

A downhill medium length par 4. Three bunkers narrow the landing area, if you're not confident out of the sand it may be better to take a 3 wood or an iron of the tee.

## **Hole 6**

A gently climbing par 4. A straight forward tee shot, but watch out for the water, which guards the left of the green.

## **Hole 7**

Possibly the toughest par 5 on the course. The narrow fairway, which falls off steeply on the right could be extremely difficult to hit when the wind is blowing straight in your face.

## **Hole 8**

A relatively tame par 4 provided that you can hit it straight and avoid all the bunkers.

## **Hole 9**

A good par 3. Don't be too frightened of the stream and waterfall on the right or you could end up in the bunkers on the right.

## **Hole 10**

A tricky little par 4 to start the back 9. Watch out for the stream, which crosses the hole twice requiring you to play both your drive and approach over water.

## **Hole 11**

A long par 4. What you see is what you get with this hole – no tricks just hit it long and straight.

## **Hole 12**

Into the wind this par 3 plays much longer than it looks. Watch out for the cavernous greenside bunkers, which are not easy to escape from.

## **Hole 13**

Short par 4 to play with drive into the wind. For short chip shot try to play over the 3 bunkers to left of the fairway.

## **Hole 14**

A medium length par 4. Stay left for the shortest carry over the stream. The raised green falls away steeply at the back so be careful not to over-hit your second shot or you will have a very tough shot back.

## **Hole 15**

A daunting over water par 3. The only lake on the back 9 guards the green on this good length par 3, so make sure you get a clean strike.

## **Hole 16**

The first par 5 on the back 9. Into the wind it is tough, but on a good day still requires a good couple of hits if you are looking to pick up a shot or two.

## **Hole 17**

A slightly downhill mid length par 4. This hole normally plays downwind and a good drive should set up a relatively easy short iron over the stream and up to the raised green.

## **Hole 18**

A very straightforward par 5. Provided you can avoid the bunkers, it is possible to reach the green in two and set yourself up for a good finish.
